POSITION SUMMARY:

The Program Coordinator will enable the expansion of the SYI by recruiting for, planning, and running one of the SYI academies under the direction of the permanent directors, and assisting with the summer mission experiences.

- Initiate and nurture relationships with high schools, churches, and organizations.
- Recruit for annual academies.
- Execute annual program on site at partner institution.
- Coordinate with personnel at applicable College or University in preparation for the annual academy.
- Coordinate with the Neighborhood Academy primarily regarding recruitment for the annual academy.
- Plan and develop curriculum under direction of SYI directors.
- Assist in the recruitment and training of annual summer staff.
- Develop curriculum for annual mission experiences in coordination with SYI directors.
- Execute annual mission experiences along with SYI directors.
- Provide general logistical programmatic support.
- · Perform other duties as assigned.
