JOB SUMMARY

The Director of Christian Education plans, implements, and supervises the approved educational ministry of the Community Presbyterian Church of Ben Avon for all ages.

Essential Functions

- Plan and organize, with the Christian Education Committee and the Adult Education Discipleship Committee, the educational ministry of the church.
- Select and maintain curriculum and spiritual reflection activities for preschool through adult education programs with committees' support.
- Implement and manage the Christian education programs for all ages, including: Sunday School (all year), Children's Day Camp, Youth Group, mission trips, retreats, and special programs in Advent and Lent, etc.
- Recruit, train, and supervise teachers and other volunteers for Sunday School and Nursery. With Safe Church team, ensure clearances are current.
- Collaborate with Pastor to do Time with the Children during worship, conduct confirmation class, and organize Avonworth Baccalaureate service.
- Assist in formulating the Christian Education budget and monitor expenses within the approved budget.
- Maintain current contact information to promote all Christian education activities using mailings, newsletter, announcements, and social media.
- Foster relationships with children and youth and their families.

Other Responsibilities

- Participate in weekly staff meetings
- Attend continuing education programs for spiritual and professional growth

Minimum Qualifications

- High School diploma and a Bachelor's Degree preferred

- Minimum of three years of ministry experience working in a church, organizing and leading Christian education programming
- Excellent written, oral communication, organizational, and networking skills

- Ability to express faith in the love of God, the grace of Jesus Christ, and the presence of the Holy Spirit

- **Biblical Knowledge:** Education in basic Bible knowledge. Able to interpret and apply Scripture to life situations. Guides others in the exploration and discovery of biblical truth and wisdom. Encourages and designs ways for others to engage in ongoing study and application of Scripture.
- **Interpersonal Skills:** Relates well with others. Demonstrates the skill of active listening and openly accepts criticism. Productively engages and resolves interpersonal conflict. Holds others accountable in the spirit of love. Engages people positively, with a demeanor of optimism and grace.
- **Flexibility:** Accepts challenges of ministry with flexibility and humor. Able to creatively think outside the box to solve problems, resolve conflict, and keep the peace.
