Bull Creek's mission has been closely linked to the programs and services of the Allegheny Valley Association of Churches for the past 60 years. In that time we have directly supported such programs as the community food bank, Family Promise, transitional and permanent housing programs and other social support services. Our denominational support includes but is not limited to One Great Hour of Sharing, Blanket Sunday and Thank offering. Our concern for the spiritual nurture and physical wellbeing of youth includes a community-wide Vacation Bible School, financial assistance for attendance at church camps and direct support of the Mars Children's home. We have established working relationships with other congregations and organizations in our area, but continue to remain open to new opportunities.
