General

The following job description is for temporary pastoral services with Carnegie Presbyterian Church (CPC).

This is a full-time position for 40 hours per week.

The Temporary Pastor shall be responsible for pastoral leadership that shall include the following:

Responsibilities and Duties

1. Serve as Moderator of the Session, upon approval by Presbytery
2. Provide leadership support for Board of Deacon’s and committees
3. Serve as Head of Staff, supervising and motivating the church staff.
4. Lead two services of worship, including Communion, Baptism, marriage and funerals.
5. Provide an outstanding biblically based preaching and teaching ministry to a church in transition.
6. Provide pastoral care for those in crisis situations, counsel as needed, and call on the sick.
7. Assist the congregation in the tasks of:
 - o - Strengthening and continuing ties with Presbytery, Synod and GA
 - o - Leading the church to a renewed vision for their future
 - o - Providing for smooth transition of congregational leadership
8. Walk with the congregation in reaching out into the community in their mission and witness.
