East Liberty Presbyterian Church is searching for a ¼ time Youth Worker to support the church's ministry to children and youth, from infancy through grade 6. The youth worker will work collaboratively with other staff and volunteers in the planning and facilitation of a broad range of ministries nurturing the spiritual and personal growth of a diverse community of children and youth.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing support and assisting with Sunday morning ministries that serve children and youth, including Church School, Extended Session, and worship. Teach lessons for either Church School or Extended Session as assigned. Ensure a safe and engaging climate for all.
- Providing leadership for our Wednesday evening youth ministry, "club 116," including:
 - co-facilitating the small group for children or younger youth: planning and leading lessons, providing classroom management and pastoral care
 - supervising children and youth in grades 1-12 for activity time (homework help, recreation, etc.) to ensure their safety and engagement
 - assisting with set up, clean up, and dismissal
- Chaperone events for children and youth in grades K-6, including Tween Events, service projects, intergenerational activities and retreats, as part of a team of staff and volunteers.

Primary Qualifications include:

- Someone of the Christian faith, with experience teaching progressive Reformed Christian faith and values in an engaging and developmentally appropriate manner.
- Experience and comfort working with diverse groups of children and youth across lines of race, gender, socio-economic class, ability, sexual identity and age in an urban setting.
- Experience and enthusiasm for facilitating spiritual formation in an intergenerational setting through periodic events that intentionally foster intergenerational community.
- Preferred education: Bachelor's Degree, ideally with training in Theology and Education.
- Must be able to pass PA Criminal Background Check, Act 33/34 clearances, FBI Clearance
