2. Letter of recommendation from a school guidance counselor, advisor, or educator.
3. A copy of their most recent transcript showing a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
4. Written proof of enrollment in a full-time baccalaureate, associate, or technical/trade program.
5. A typed or printed essay of 900-1500 words on required topic.
6. A completed application with all required documents.
