

# Congregational Meeting for Dissolution of Pastoral Relationship

## AGENDA

The clerk of session serves as a secretary of the meeting, or, if the clerk cannot be present, a secretary pro tem may be appointed.

1. Convening prayer
2.   - Interim Pastor or Temporary Pastor search process by the Session in collaboration with the Presbytery Branch Minister/COM
  - Nomination and election by the congregation of a Pastor Nominating Committee
8. The presbytery policy concerning former pastors and their families is shared by the clerk of session with the congregation (and printed in both bulletin and newsletter).
9. The minutes of this special meeting may be approved before adjournment or submitted to the Session for subsequent approval.
