Policy Statement on Scholarships Granted by Pittsburgh Presbytery's Peacemaking Ministry Team

- ✍✍ The Presbytery Peacemaking Ministry Team wishes to encourage individuals and/or local congregations to participate in leadership events or opportunities that will enable them to promote and conduct peacemaking at the congregational, community, and global levels of our world.
- ✍✍ To do this, the Pittsburgh Presbytery Peacemaking Ministry Team (PPPMT) will give priority to events and opportunities that are recommended by or provided by the Pittsburgh Presbytery Peacemaking Program of the Presbyterian Church (USA).
- ✍✍ In good stewardship of the limited financial resources available to this ministry team, priority will be given to requests for scholarship aid from individuals or groups who provide leadership in the presbytery or local church peacemaking organizations.
- ✍✍ First-time participants in peacemaking events will receive priority consideration, particularly those who would not be able to attend without scholarship aid.
- ✍✍ Any request for scholarship aid for any other purpose than that stated above must show the relationship between the purpose of that request and peacemaking efforts, in a written application, to be considered and approved by the PPPMT.
- ✍✍ All applicants will be expected to pay a portion of the cost for such participation, as a witness to their personal commitment to peacemaking.
- ✍✍ Recipients of the scholarship will be expected to make a report of their experiences and learnings to the PPPMT at the earliest, mutually-convenient time and be available to share their information with other groups within the presbytery as requested.
- ✍✍ Publicity will be given to all Presbytery Peacemaking opportunities and events, including the availability of limited scholarships and application forms for scholarships.
- ✍✍ The deadline for receiving applications will be one month prior to the conference/event deadline, and in time for the meeting of the PPPMT meeting. Completed applications are to be sent to:
