Keynote by Rev. Wayne Younger


On January 27th you're invited to bring your middle and high school age students (and leaders) to the Event 2.0. Building on last year's inaugural event, we hope to bring together youth from across our region for an evening of worship, fun, growth, and fellowship. The model for the evening will be similar to the "club time" at a retreat, mission trip or summer camp and feature games/contests, music, and a keynote speaker. Our keynote speaker this year will be Rev. Wayne Younger, who currently serves as the Executive Director of the Pittsburgh Project. Wayne is a gifted and experienced communicator, having served in the local church and spoken to teenagers for many years in various venues, and will engage and challenge all who attend. We will be gathering in The Pittsburgh Project's Sanctuary space which centrally located on Pittsburgh's north side and has ample parking. Doors will open at 5:30 and we will officially start at 6:00pm. We have room for 300 people, which we anticipate will be enough, but we'd encourage you to register early to make sure your group is able to attend.



- We've designed the registration options for this event so that there's option for every church
- Church Registration - \$150 - For larger churches you can register everyone - no matter how many people you bring - for \$150. We want an approximate number when you register, but you're not tied to that number in any way.
 - Individual Registration - \$5 per person (before January 8th) - For smaller groups, you can register the exact number of people you'll be bringing and only pay for that amount. And if you do so before January 7th it's only \$5 per person. It will jump to \$10 per person after that. Also, you may drop up to two spots at no penalty. (So if you register for 8, and only six come you'll pay for 6. But if you register for 8 and five come, you'll still owe for 6)
 - Under-resourced Church Option - We know that some churches are in under-resourced communities, and even \$5 per person is simply out of reach for some of your families (and churches). If this is the case, we don't want to leave anyone out of this event, and you are welcome to come - no matter how much you and your group can (or cannot) afford.
