I am Achol Majok Kur Kier a female South Sudanese national, aged fifty two(54) years old, born in Bieu village Western Upper Nile Province from Dinka parents on. January 1963

I grew up in Bentiu district by then, Bentiu where I started my primary school education and secondary school in Northern Sudan. Bentiu is a multicultural area whereby Nuer, Dinka and chuluk co-exist.

I was baptized in Catholic church in Bentiu in 1971, while I joined the Presbyterian Evangelical church (SSPEC)in 1993 when I got married as I believe that in this world we serve Our lovely God in different houses and I want to be with my new family (my husband and my children).

Dedicating my life to the church, I was ordained as a deaconess. I become one of the women leaders in SSPEC. I was elected as chairperson for women desk and by virtue of office as a chairperson of WD I became a member of the executive committee in SSCC.

I have been and will be actively engaged in peace and reconciliation in the South Sudan.

I fully participated in all the peace initiatives since December 19, 2013 to date under the umbrella of SSCC women desk. we continue to fast and pray I believe that through prayers, God will listen to us.

Through the support of our partners SSPEC women desk managed to conduct sessions on trauma healing. SSPEC women desk took the lead as the whole congregation was affected and took refuge to UNMIS protection camps.

I'm also engaged in mobilizing /organizing SSPEC women to o take part in National Dialogue declared by the president of the republic of South Sudan.

The areas of my concern and expertise are peace & reconciliation, stability, education for all in general and girl education in particular, all these factors lead to poverty alleviation. in the absence of peace there will be no education no health services, no food no development.

I have a bachelor degree of education from University of Juba in 1991, I have full command of English and Arabic Languages, I'm currently working in Greater Pioneer Operating Company as a secondee of Nile Petroleum Operating Company holding a position of deputy General Manger.

When I moved to Khartoum in 1986-1999, As a South Sudanese female professional teacher, I dedicated my time to mobilize of Southerners in the displaced camps around Khartoum, Kosti and Kinana to send their children to schools because education is a right in normal and emergency situation and I was strongly convinced that education was one of the key factors for the devastated long war in the Sudan

In 1999 I decided to join Southern Sudan struggle movement to serve my country men and women on what I could do at my level, I joined UNICEF -Operation Life Line where I worked in three areas of SARA, RASS and FRA in facilitating education programes to be implemented in Greater Upper Nile Region, through my initiative, UNICEF outpost(later) zonal office was established in Nyal -Panyijiar County in 2001 as it was the safer place in the whole of Upper to give a better services to the region as the main offices were in Rumbek and Yambio.

I'm a mother of two (children) a boy and a girl who are currently studying in UK and God fearing husband who dedicated his life to Jesus Christ. caring father, I'm from Dinka tribe who have broken the norms of Nilelotics tribes, to mention a few, (who decided to complete her education before getting married, who got married to a Nuer man during the 1991 split. who got married at the age of 29 yr old)
